

## Victim of Fruitport Township fatal crash identified

FRUITPORT TOWNSHIP, MI - Authorities have identified Glen Giant, 75, of Fruitport as the driver who died in a two-vehicle crash Saturday, March 7, at Mount Garfield and Quarterline roads.

According to witness account, Giant around 1:30 p.m. was driving a small sedan southbound on Quarterline, Fruitport Township Director of Public Safety Ken Doctor said. Giant stopped for the stop sign but then pulled out into the path of a Ford Ranger pickup truck that was westbound on Mount Garfield, Doctor said. Traffic on Mount Garfield has the right of way at that intersection.

The collision killed Giant and injured his wife and front-seat passenger, Carol Giant, Doctor said. She was transported to a local hospital and was reported in stable condition after the accident.

The driver of the pickup, Patrick Stewart, suffered minor injuries, Doctor said. That driver was not at fault in the accident, Doctor said.

After the accident, Giant's car could be seen right-side-up in the yard of an unoccupied home on the intersection's southwest corner.

Mount Garfield Road was closed for a period of time after the accident from the Lakes Mall entrance to the Quarterline intersection.
